# A-F Cut Scores

The Arizona Department of Education (ADE) presented impact data on possible cut scores for A-F Letter Grades for the 2021-2022 school year for traditional brick and mortar K-8 and 9-12 schools, "hybrid" brick and mortar schools (schools that have grade configurations that cut across K-8 and 9-12), alternative schools and Arizona Online Instruction (AOI) schools in the September 26<sup>th</sup> Meeting.

The Board approved the 2021-2022 accountability cut scores as recommended. The cut scores use the prior year option for K-8, and standard deviation option for both 9-12 and alternative schools.

## **A-F Appeals Process and Procedures**

The Board approved the accountability appeals process and procedures as recommended. The policies and procedures were modified from prior years to include:

- The universal impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic
- An additional example pertaining to school closures
- Provisions for appeals citing incorrect data

The appeal window will be open from when ADE releases letter grade to November 15<sup>th</sup>, at 5:00PM.
