Resolution on the 2020-2021 School Year Statewide School Accountability System

Adopted by the Arizona State Board of Education December 14, 2020

Whereas, pursuant to A.R.S. § 15-241, it is the State Board of Education's duty and responsibility to adopt an annual achievement profile using A through F letter grade classifications.

Whereas, the State Board of Education highly values the accountability system and statewide assessment data to ensure Arizona students are ready for college and career by the time they graduate high school and to provide actionable data to help improve student outcomes.

Whereas, the State Board of Education recognizes the challenges Arizona's schools, educators and families face in continuing to provide an education and other essential services to over one million Arizona students during a global pandemic.

Therefore, be it resolved, by the State Board of Education:

1. That the state administer the statewide assessment to all students in the spring of 2021, collect achievement data from the 2020-2021 school year and appropriately report achievement data for the 2020-2021 school year; and
2. That the state should not award school letter grades for the 2020-2021 school year.
