A motion was made by Board President Miller to approve the recommendation by the Department of Education for membership on both the English Language Arts subcommittee and the Mathematics subcommittee. The motion was seconded by Member Mari Koerner.

AMENDMENT – (1:34:26) Recording 1

Member Taylor moved for an amendment to the motion to replace a Math subcommittee member with Mr. Mike Robinette and to replace an ELA subcommittee member with Claire Morgan. The amendment was seconded by Member Chuck Schmidt.

AMENDMENT to the AMENDMENT – (1:45)Recording 1

Superintendent Douglas moved to amend Mr. Taylor's amendment. The amendment would remove the Early Childhood position on the ELA subcommittee and the Early Childhood position on the Math subcommittee and add an advanced Math slot to the Math subcommittee. The motion was seconded by Member Tarro.
