## 2022-2023 A-F Letter Grades Released

Today, the Arizona Department of Education released the 2022-2023 A-F School Letter Grades at the direction of the Arizona State Board of Education. Letter grades are accessible to the public at https://azsbe.az.gov/parents/a-f-school-letter-grades.

A-F School Letter Grades are the state accountability model used annually to measure school performance. The system measures year-to-year student academic growth and proficiency in English language arts, mathematics and science; the proficiency and academic growth of English language learners; indicators that elementary students are ready for success in high school and high school students are ready for success in a career or in higher education; and high school graduation rates.

Schools have until November 15<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 PM to appeal their letter grade. Schools who appeal their letter grade will be marked as "UR" (under review) until the State Board of Education takes action on their appeal at the December 4, 2023 meeting. Depending on the outcome of appeals, individual school and local education agency letter grades may change.

Below is the breakdown of the 2022-2023 letter grades by school type, prior to any appeal submission:
