

# 3. Presentation, discussion and possible action to recommend opening proposed rule R7-2-615.01 Special Education Endorsements

Deputy Director Baden presented the item and Bruce DuPlanty with the Arizona Department of Education provided information.

Committee members held discussion on the item.

The Committee agreed to modify the proposal to: 1) require three years of full-time teaching experience for both the provisional endorsement and the full endorsement; 2) retain the expandability of the certificate; 3) require 15 clock hours of practicum for the provisional endorsement and 45 clock hours of practicum for the full endorsement; and 4) other technical changes identified by staff.

The motion was made by Dr. Lyding and seconded by Member Fera to incorporate the changes above into the proposal and recommend the Board open rulemaking procedures for R7-2-615.01 Special Education Endorsements. The vote was unanimous by a voice vote
