Discussion of working	The Chair thanked everyone on the Subcommittee for their hard
groups' progress and next	work in developing the ELA standards.

	comments were reviewed. She stated that the groups utilized a
	rubric and consensus model to analyze the standards, and reviewed
	changes for clarity, cognitive demand, and measurability.
	The next steps are to create and introduction to the standards as
	well as a glossary, and to finalize the standards.
	Sean Ross from ADE thanked all of the Subcommittee members.
	Dr. Schmidt asked if the Chair would prefer that Dr. Schmidt
	gave an update to Academic Standards Development Committee on
	the ELA standards. The Chair stated that she would prefer to give
	the presentation.
	Dr. Schmidt mentioned that a call-in number would be available
	for the Academic Standards Development Committee meeting so
	that out-of-towners are able to listen to the meeting. There were no
	out-of-towners on the Subcommittee. Dr. Schmidt asked the
	members to email her if they planned to attend or call-in to the
	meeting to ensure there is not a quorum of the Subcommittee.

	Dr. Schmidt asked for an update on phonics. Member Danya
	Burke stated that the phonics was addressed in the K-4 standards,
	and new standards had been added.
	Dr. Schmidt asked for an update on cursive. Member Arlynn
	Godinez indicated that cursive was addressed in the third grade
	standards both in reading and writing.
	Dr. Schmidt asked for an update regarding the balance between
	informational text v. literature. Member Alita Miller explained
	how the percentages came about from science and social studies.
	The working groups are addressing this confusion.
	Dr. Schmidt asked for an update on the guidance documents and
	asked for an explanation on the process for creating the guidance
	documents. The Chair stated that the Subcommittee is working on
	these and will include them in her updates for the Academic
	Standards Development Committee.
	Member Debbie LeBlanc discussed the confusion regarding the
	use of i.e. and e.g. in the standards and stated that these "examples"
	(which are not really examples) will be eliminated from the
	standards.
	Member Anita Miller discussed that the working groups had
	addressed the difference between standards, curriculum, and
	instruction that may cause confusion in the field. She stated that
	the working groups discussed the differences and that this will be
	addressed within the introduction to the standards.
	Dr. Schmidt thanked everyone on the Subcommittee for their hard
	work on the revision of the ELA standards.
